With a school population of approximately 300 students, Redwater School provides a Grade 5-12 education in the Town of Redwater. The staff works toward meeting the diverse needs of all students through differentiated instruction, assessment for learning, and programming. Redwater School believes strongly that our staff and students are “making a difference”.

The school has a strong academic program and continues to develop highly achieving students. A significant percentage of Redwater School’s graduating classes have received Rutherford Scholarships made available by the Province of Alberta. The community of Redwater actively supports the students through a variety of scholarships to post secondary institutions. These scholarships, available only to Redwater School students, amount to approximately \$6000 annually. Sturgeon School Division also awards scholarships to our graduating students with honours marks.

The school offers many exciting options through Career and Technology Studies courses such as: Construction, Communication Technology, Fashion Studies, Information Processing, Logos Connect, and Foods. Redwater School takes great pride in the many enriching activities provided to our students. Our Fine Arts program continues to grow, with courses offered in Band, Guitar, Choral, Drama, Musical Theatre and Art.

Further opportunities for Redwater students are available through the Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP), Green Certificate in Agriculture, and Career Internship. It provides opportunities for students to embark on a career path while continuing their high school program. Students can earn credits at the same time as they earn hours toward their apprenticeship, agricultural career or post secondary so when they graduate from high school, they may have their first year completed in one of the 50 trades, and 16 Green Certificate programs existing in Alberta. Students also can earn work experience credits.

Additionally, sports and extracurricular programs are a priority, ensuring that the school provides a well-rounded quality education for all students. As a smaller school, Redwater students are afforded a greater opportunity to participate in a variety of activities and “make a difference”.

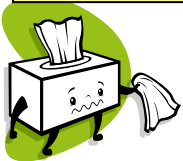
