## CPR & AED Training



We were so lucky to have The Heart and Stroke Foundation install a new lifesaving Automated External Defibrillator (AED) and train 100 Grade 8-10 students in our school as part of an initiative to place AEDs where Alberta youth gather, play and learn. Students met in the gym for 2 hours on November 27 for training on CPR and on the AED machine. This was a great opportunity to learn this life saving skill.
