Redwater School is a BYOD school from grades 7-12. That means that we require students to bring their own devices from home.

A device brought for learning must meet the following requirements:

- Internet ready (chrome browser)
- Ability to type (full keyboard required)
- Battery life of a full school day (6 hours)
- Labelled for identification
- Google Apps for Education (GAFF) friendly
- Not a cellphone
