
Grandfather Teachings (For April)




New Moon Information

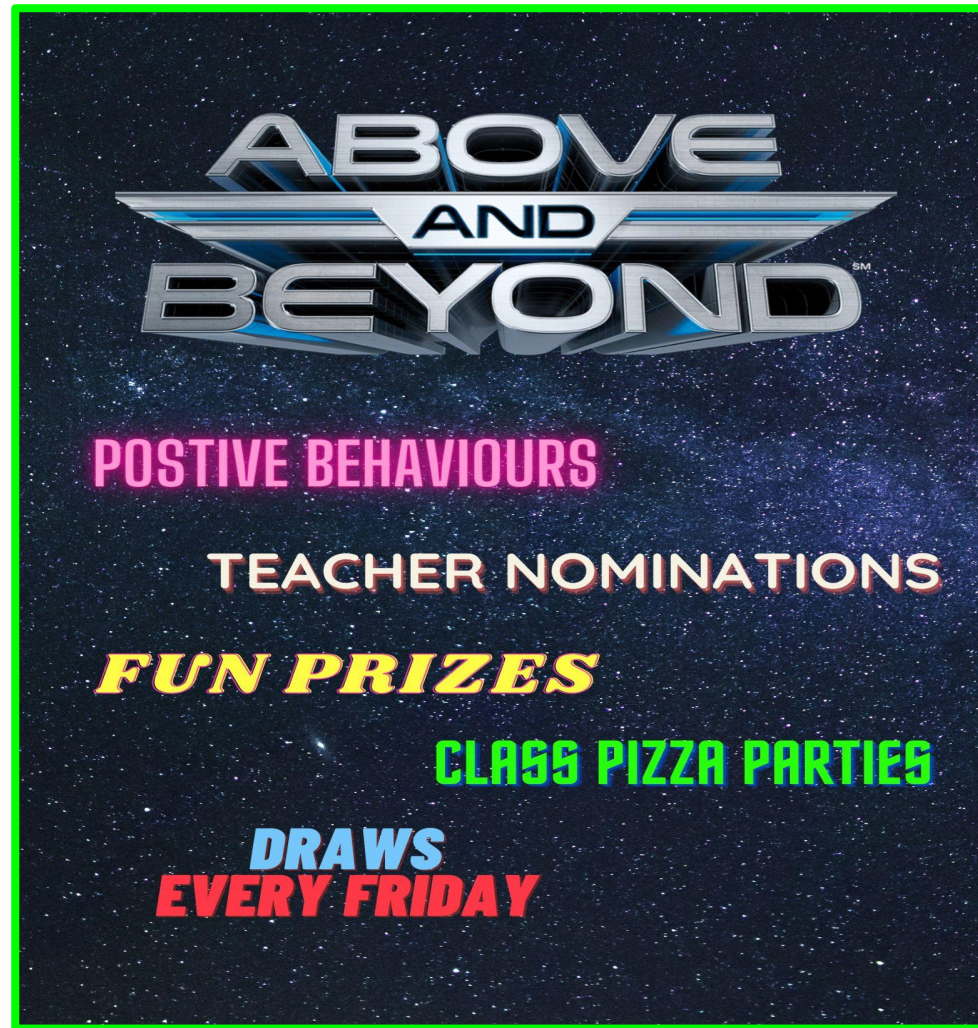
Words From The Wellness Hub

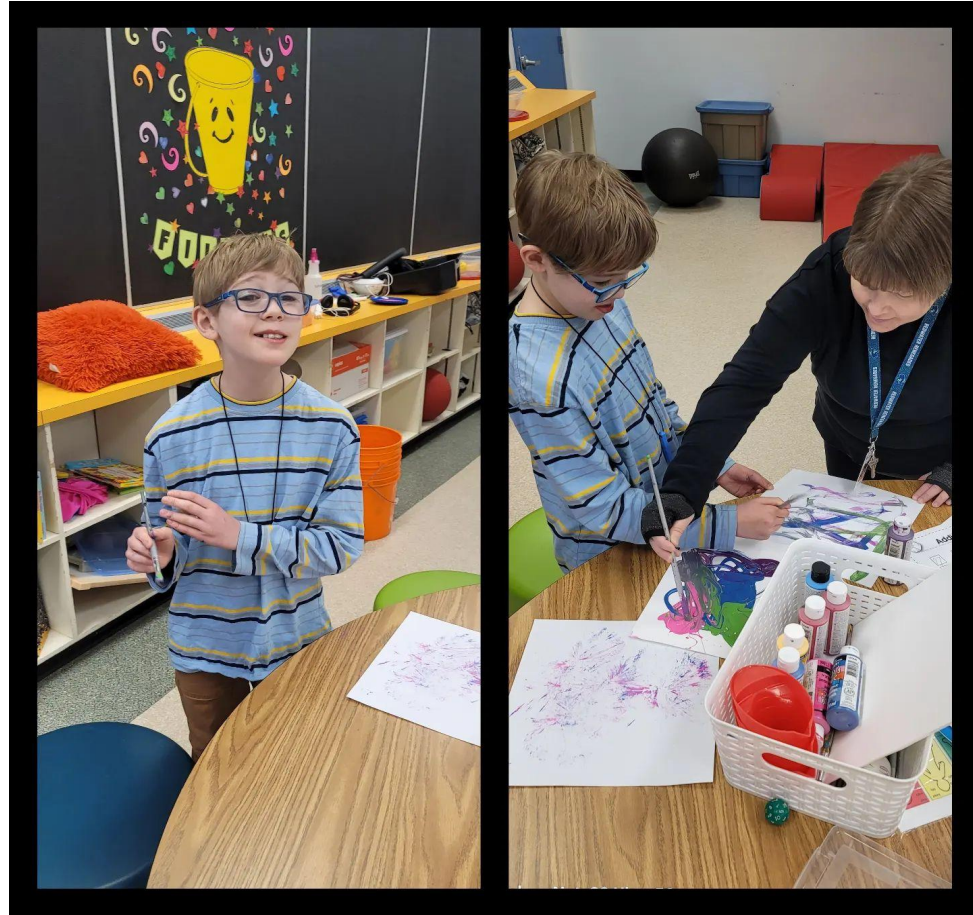

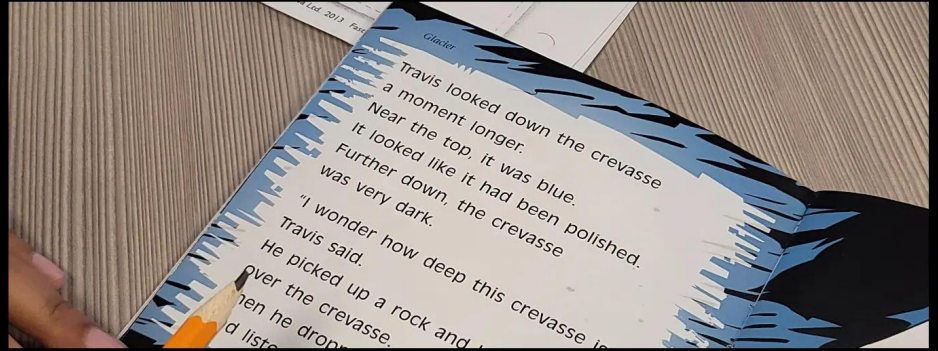

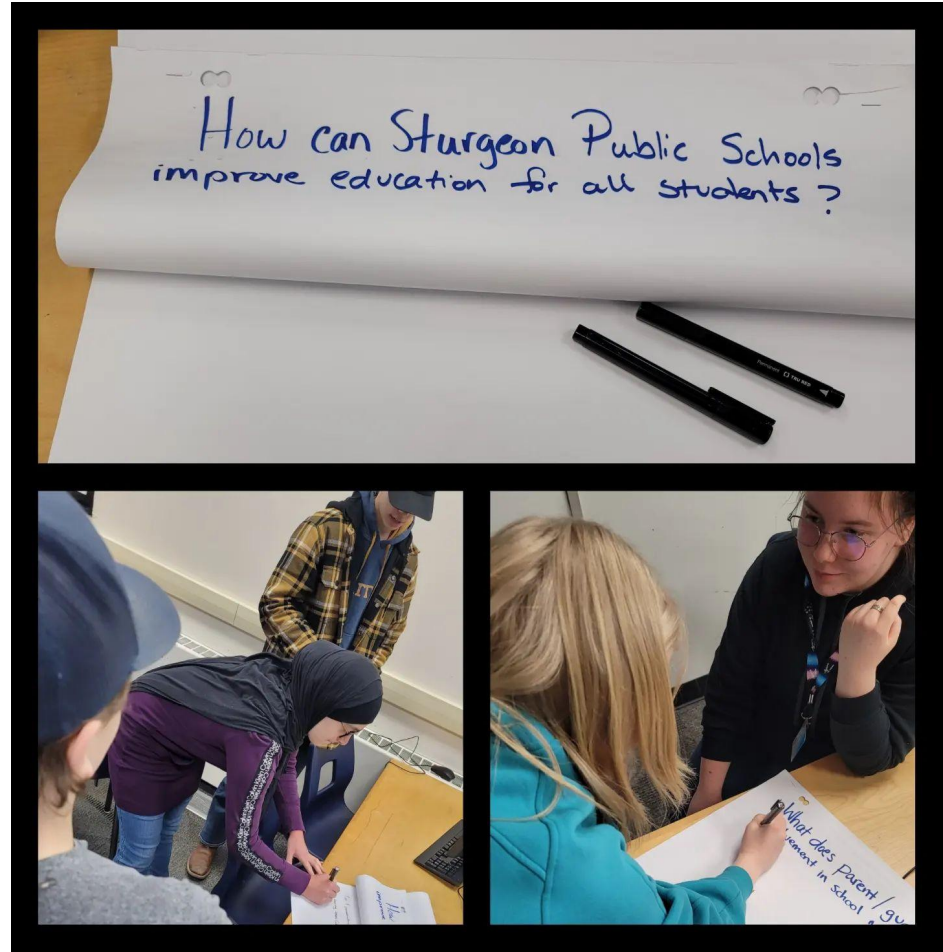
